

Blåtand's guidelines for purchases of wild berries in Sweden

The following applies to all suppliers of wild Swedish berries (bilberries, lingonberries, cloudberries and wild raspberries) to Blåtand AB.

- The supplier must be registered as a business in Sweden (hold an F-tax certificate).
- The supplier must comply with Swedish legislation and case law and with rules and recommendations specific to the berry industry issued by Swedish authorities. The supplier must not purchase and supply berries from a party that does not comply with applicable Swedish laws and rules.
- The supplier must promptly pay all taxes and duties arising on the sale of berries to Blåtand.
- The supplier must provide berry pickers with information on Swedish public access rights (e.g. no litter).
- The supplier must provide berry pickers with information on basic food hygiene.
- The supplier must provide berry pickers with information on when hunting may take place and how they should then act.
- The supplier must comply with the code of conduct for responsible berry purchasing issued by the Swedish Association of Food Retailers and the Swedish Food Federation.
